MSCC Offering Short-Term, Special-Interest Classes

Mid-South Community College has scheduled a variety of short-term, special-interest courses for March and April.

The one-hour college credit classes include Auto Maintenance, Computer Basics, Exercise for Seniors, Green Living with Decorating, Photo Editing Basics, Self Defense Basics, Social Media, and Special Topic in Literature (course includes discussion of the Charles Stanley book, "Emotions").

Enrollment in some of the classes is limited, so early registration is advised. Priority will go to paid enrollees. Classes will not meet during Spring Break (March 24-29)

Self Defense Basics (EMGT 1001-01) will meet on Tuesdays, 4:30-6 p.m., March 4-April 9. Dennis Brewer of West Memphis Martial Arts Academy will teach students the basics of self-protection against physical attack. In-county tuition is \$90, and



supply/course fees are \$17. The class will meet in the MSCC Wellness Center on the South Campus.

Photo-Editing Basics (DIGM 1001-01) will meet on Wednesdays, 3-4 p.m., March 5-April 9. Pete Sullivan, MSCC's graphic designer, will help course participants make the most of their digital photographs. Students should bring a digital camera or smart phone to class. In-county tuition is \$90, and supply/course fees are \$17. The class will meet in the MSCC's University Center on the South Campus.

Exercise for Seniors (HPED 1111-01) will meet on Wednesdays, 10-11 a.m., March 5-April 9 in the Wellness Center. Elbert "Junior" Weaver, MSCC Intramurals Coordinator and veteran athletic coach, will direct the class and focus on a low-impact exercise routine for maintaining flexibility, muscle tone, and heart health.. In-county tuition is \$90 (senior citizen waivers apply), and supply/course fees are \$17. The class will meet in the College's Wellness Center.

Special Topic in Literature (ENGL 1001-01) will meet Fridays, 11:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m., March 7-April 11, in the Donald W. Reynolds Center for Educational Excellence. Dr. Jeannie Oliver, MSCC Coordinator of Advising, will direct the class which will include readings and discussions of "Emotions: Confront the Lies. Conquer with Truth" by Charles Stanley. In-county tuition is \$90.

Auto Maintenance (HTDM 1001-01) will meet Saturdays, 10-11:30 a.m., March 8-March 28, in the Marion Berry Renewable Energy Center on the College's North Campus. Taught by MSCC Diesel Technology instructor Darren Brooks, the class will emphasize basic preventive maintenance techniques such as checking and changing oil, replacing fuses, and checking fluids. In-county tuition is \$90, and supply/course fees are \$17.

Computer Basics (COMP 1001-31) will meet Mondays, 5-6 p.m., March 10-April 14, in the University Center. Course participants will learn the basics of operating a computer from instructor Fredreca Cowan, an adjunct business faculty member at MSCC. In-county tuition is \$90, and supply/course fees are \$17.

Green Living with Decorating (ARTS 1001-01) will meet Tuesdays, 4:30-5:30 p.m., March 11-April 15, in Magruder Hall on the South Campus. Under the direction of Lee Ann Turner, who serves as the University of Central Arkansas representative on the

Mid-South campus, the course will address the selection process for environmentally green materials for home improvement and decorating projects throughout the house. In-county tuition is \$90, and supply/course fees are \$17.



Social Media (DIGM 1011-31) will meet Thursdays, 5-6 p.m., March 13-April 17, in the University Center. Taught by Fredreca Cowan, the course will help participants learn how to get the most out of Facebook and Twitter. Students should bring a smart phone to class. In-county tuition is \$90, and supply/course fees are \$17.
