ASU Mid-South Gearing up for Fall Registration after Successful Summer Session

Arkansas State University Mid-South is gearing up for the Fall 2018 semester after seeing an increase in summer enrollment. ASU Mid-South faculty and staff are currently assisting students in registering for a variety of classes. The college has expanded offerings and flexible options to help students fit their classes into their demanding lifestyles. In addition to traditional classroomstyle classes, online classes, short-term classes and Saturday classes are available.

The college experienced a 9% increase in headcount enrollment and an 18% in the number of credit hours taken during the summer term, a possible result of the renewed ability to award federal financial aid funds during the summer term. "It's nice that students who are eligible for the Pell grant did not have to suspend their education over the summer," said Crystal Burger, Director of Financial Aid for Mid-South. "So often, that break during the summer term can be the thing that causes a student to suspend continuing their classes. The ability to keep their momentum going helps students stay focused on completing their programs. Otherwise, life sometimes just gets in the way."

"We're looking forward to having our students back on campus for the fall term," added Vice Chancellor for Student Services, Jeremy Reece. "There's just something exciting about the fall semester and seeing our returning students as well as the new faces of our incoming freshmen."

The final day for full semester registration is Monday, August 6. After that date, students can still register with a \$100 late fee. Classes begin on August 20. Registration for short-term classes will continue through October 8.
