ASU Mid-South Designated as Certified Education Center by Fabricators & Manufacturers Association, Intl.

Arkansas State University Mid-South has been designated as a Certified Education Center (CEC) by the Fabricators & Manufacturers Association, Intl. (FMA). ASU Mid-South is one of approximately 60 CEC locations in the US and is the first CEC location in the Mid-South. A Certified Education Center is a training facility offering manufacturing technology programs engaged in a mission, in partnership with FMA, to interest students in pursuing careers in the metal forming and fabricating industry.

This designation ensures the college remains on the cutting edge of manufacturing technology training by offering training to instructors, curriculum support and assistance in securing some types of equipment. A CEC designation also comes with acknowledgement on the FMA website and allows the College to offer certificate programs to students as well as host specialty training to meet the needs of the local community.

Fabrication involves processes in which metals are taken from a raw state to a finished product. The Fabricators & Manufacturers Association helps thousands of FMA members overcome challenges such as increased global competition to employee skills gaps faced by modern day manufacturing industry, and leverage the opportunities. FMA also partners with educational institutions across North America to support the schools that are preparing the future workforce.






