#### **MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION**

##### **Part- or Full-time**

1031 (78%) part-time students (1-11 hrs)  
294 (22%) full-time students (12 or more hrs)

##### **First-time Students**

143 (11%) are first-time entering, award seeking freshmen (Fall 2019 Cohort)  
528 (40%) first time at ASUMS

##### **Remediation**

82 (6%) of all students are currently enrolled in one or more remedial courses  
44 (31%) of the 143 Fall 2019 *cohort* students are enrolled in one or more remedial courses

##### **Day/Night/Alternative Delivery Enrollment**

1051 (79%) are enrolled in day classes, with 839 (63%) enrolled exclusively in day classes  
130 (10%) are enrolled in night classes, with 40 (3%) enrolled exclusively in night classes  
427 (32%) enrolled in alternative delivery courses (internet, hybrid), with 177 (13%) enrolled exclusively in alternative delivery  
269 (20%) are enrolled in a combination of day, night, and/or alternative delivery classes

##### **High School (Concurrent or Dual) Enrollment**

Of the 662 high school students enrolled:

- 484 (73%) are enrolled in Technical Center classes.
- 166 (25%) are enrolled in General Education classes.
- 12 (2%) are enrolled in both Tech and General Educ. classes.

## RETENTION

### All Students:

Of the 1423 students enrolled in the Fall of 2018, 568 (40%) re-enrolled for Fall 2019.

Of the 1295 students enrolled in the Spring 2019, 606 (47%) re-enrolled for the Fall 2019.

### Degree-Seeking Students of Non-Graduates:

Of the 419 students who were degree-seeking in the Fall 2018, 159 (40%) re-enrolled for the Fall 2019.

Of the 375 students who were degree-seeking in the Spring 2019, 190 (51%) re-enrolled for the Fall 2019.

### Cohort Retention of Non-Graduates from Previous Two Years

Of the 21 Spring 2019 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 9 (43%) re-enrolled for Fall 2019.

Of the 123 Fall 2018 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 44 (36%) re-enrolled for Fall 2019.

Of the 28 Spring 2018 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 4 (14%) re-enrolled for Fall 2019.

Of the 137 Fall 2017 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 18 (13%) re-enrolled for Fall 2019.
