#### **MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION**

##### **Part- or Full-time**

928 (77%) part-time students (1-11 hrs)  
275 (23%) full-time students (12 or more hrs)

##### **First-time Students**

122 (10%) are first-time entering, award seeking freshmen (Fall 2020 Cohort)  
467 (39%) first time at ASUMS

##### **Remediation**

42 (3%) of all students are currently enrolled in one or more remedial courses  
25 (20%) of the 122 Fall 2020 *cohort* students are enrolled in one or more remedial courses

##### **Day/Night/Alternative Delivery Enrollment**

830 (69%) are enrolled in day classes, with 618 (51%) enrolled exclusively in day classes  
98 (8%) are enrolled in night classes, with 49 (4%) enrolled exclusively in night classes  
529 (44%) enrolled in alternative delivery courses (internet, hybrid), with 294 (24%) enrolled exclusively in alternative delivery  
242 (20%) are enrolled in a combination of day, night, and/or alternative delivery classes

##### **High School (Concurrent or Dual) Enrollment**

Of the 567 high school students enrolled:

- 341 (60%) are enrolled in Technical Center classes.
- 207 (37%) are enrolled in General Education classes.
- 19 (3%) are enrolled in both Tech and General Educ. classes.

## RETENTION

### All Students:

Of the 1325 students enrolled in the Fall of 2019, 525 (40%) re-enrolled for Fall 2020.

Of the 1144 students enrolled in the Spring 2020, 568 (50%) re-enrolled for the Fall 2020.

### Degree-Seeking Students of Non-Graduates:

Of the 366 students who were degree-seeking in the Fall 2019, 152 (42%) re-enrolled for the Fall 2020.

Of the 314 students who were degree-seeking in the Spring 2020, 181 (58%) re-enrolled for the Fall 2020.

### Cohort Retention of Non-Graduates from Previous Two Years

Of the 33 Spring 2020 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 17 (52%) re-enrolled for Fall 2020.

Of the 115 Fall 2019 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 49 (43%) re-enrolled for Fall 2020.

Of the 21 Spring 2019 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 5 (24%) re-enrolled for Fall 2020.

Of the 109 Fall 2018 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 23 (21%) re-enrolled for Fall 2020.
