Part- or Full-time

909 (79%) part-time students (1-11 hrs)

Remediation

50 (4%) of all students are currently enrolled in one or more remedial courses
12 (32%) of the 38 Spring 2020 *cohort* students are enrolled in one or more remedial courses

Day/Night/Alternative Delivery Enrollment

904 (79%) are enrolled in day classes, with 696 (61%) enrolled exclusively in day classes
125 (11%) are enrolled in night classes, with 32 (3%) enrolled exclusively in night classes
406 (35%) are enrolled in alternative delivery courses (internet, hybrid), with 149 (13%) enrolled exclusively in alternative delivery
267 (23%) are enrolled in a combination of day, night, and/or alternative delivery classes

High School (Concurrent or Dual) Enrollment

Of the 562 High school students enrolled:
544 (97%) are enrolled exclusively in day classes.
5 (.8%) is enrolled exclusively in alternative classes.
13 (2%) are enrolled in a combination of day, night and alternative classes

Fall to Spring Retention

Of the 1325 students enrolled in the Fall of 2019, 955 (72%) re-enrolled for the Spring 2020.
Of the 1295 students enrolled in the Spring of 2019, 494 (38%) re-enrolled for the Spring 2020.

Cohort Retention of non-graduates from Previous Two Years

Of the 41 Fall 2018 cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 15 (37%) re-enrolled for Spring 2020.
Of the 28 Spring 2018 cohort students, 26 (93%) re-enrolled for the Spring 2020.
Of the 123 Fall 2019 cohort students, 77 (63%) re-enrolled for the Spring 2020.
Of the 22 Spring 2019 cohort students, 15 (68%) re-enrolled for the Spring 2020.
