Part- or Full-time

Remediation

24 (2%) of all students are currently enrolled in one or more remedial courses

Day/Night/Alternative Delivery Enrollment

530 (53%) are enrolled in day classes, with 364 (36%) enrolled exclusively in day classes
92 (9%) are enrolled in night classes, with 43 (4%) enrolled exclusively in night classes
593 (59%) are enrolled in alternative delivery courses (internet, hybrid), with 389 (39%) enrolled exclusively in alternative delivery
206 (21%) are enrolled in a combination of day, night, and/or alternative delivery classes

High School (Concurrent or Dual) Enrollment

Of the 453 High school students enrolled:
297 (65%) are enrolled exclusively in day classes.
93 (21%) is enrolled exclusively in alternative classes.
63 (14%) are enrolled in a combination of day, night and alternative classes

Fall to Spring Retention

Of the 1203 students enrolled in the Fall of 2020, 828 (69%) re-enrolled for the Spring 2021.
Of the 1144 students enrolled in the Spring of 2020, 449 (39%) re-enrolled for the Spring 2021.

Cohort Retention of non-graduates from Previous Two Years

Of the 102 Fall 2019 cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 31 (30%) re-enrolled for Spring 2021.
Of the 1 Spring 2019 cohort students, 0 re-enrolled for the Spring 2021.
Of the 92 Fall 2020 cohort students, 68 (74%) re-enrolled for the Spring 2021.
Of the 38 Spring 2020 cohort students, 17 (45%) re-enrolled for the Spring 2021.
