Part- or Full-time

844 (78%) part-time students (1-11 hrs)

131 (12%) are first-time entering, award seeking freshmen (Fall 2021 Cohort)
390 (36%) first time at ASUMS

Remediation

70 (6%) of all students are currently enrolled in one or more remedial courses
41 (31%) of the 131 Fall 2021 *cohort* students are enrolled in one or more remedial courses

Day/Night/Alternative Delivery Enrollment

708 (66%) are enrolled in day classes, with 554 (51%) enrolled exclusively in day classes
71 (7%) are enrolled in night classes, with 71 (7%) enrolled exclusively in night classes
491 (46%) enrolled in alternative delivery courses (internet, hybrid), with 305 (28%) enrolled exclusively in alternative delivery
147 (14%) are enrolled in a combination of day, night, and/or alternative delivery classes

High School (Concurrent or Dual) Enrollment

Of the 490 high school students enrolled:

- 308 (63%) are enrolled in Technical Center classes.
- 170 (35%) are enrolled in General Education classes.
- 12 (2%) are enrolled in both Tech and General Educ. classes.

RETENTION

All Students:

Of the 1203 students enrolled in the Fall of 2020, 500 (42%) re-enrolled for Fall 2021.

Of the 1002 students enrolled in the Spring 2021, 516 (52%) re-enrolled for the Fall 2021.

Degree-Seeking Students of Non-Graduates:

Of the 297 students who were degree-seeking in the Fall 2020, 130 (44%) re-enrolled for the Fall 2021.

Of the 272 students who were degree-seeking in the Spring 2021, 147 (54%) re-enrolled for the Fall 2021.

Cohort Retention of Non-Graduates from Previous Two Years

Of the 21 Spring 2021 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 10 (48%) re-enrolled for Fall 2021.

Of the 90 Fall 2020 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 41 (46%) re-enrolled for Fall 2021.

Of the 29 Spring 2020 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 7 (24%) re-enrolled for Fall 2021.

Of the 91 Fall 2019 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 15 (16%) re-enrolled for Fall 2021.
