**MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION**

**Part- or Full-time**

814 (83%) part-time students (1-11 hrs)  
165 (17%) full-time students (12 or more hrs)

**First-time Students**

108 (11%) are first-time entering, award seeking freshmen (Fall 2022 Cohort)  
203 (21%) first time at ASUMS

**Remediation**

85 (9%) of all students are currently enrolled in one or more remedial courses  
44 (41%) of the 108 Fall 2022 *cohort* students are enrolled in one or more remedial courses

**Day/Night/Alternative Delivery Enrollment**

625 (64%) are enrolled in day classes, with 508 (52%) enrolled exclusively in day classes  
83 (8%) are enrolled in night classes, with 39 (4%) enrolled exclusively in night classes  
452 (46%) enrolled in alternative delivery courses (internet, hybrid), with 292 (30%) enrolled exclusively in online & hybrid delivery  
140 (14%) are enrolled in a combination of day, night, and/or alternative delivery classes

**High School (Concurrent or Dual) Enrollment**

Of the 472 high school students enrolled:  
▪ 304 (64%) are enrolled in Technical Center classes.

- 159 (34%) are enrolled in General Education classes.
- 9 (2%) are enrolled in both Tech and General Educ. classes.

## RETENTION

### All Students:

Of the 1077 students enrolled in the Fall of 2021, 441 (41%) re-enrolled for Fall 2022.

Of the 901 students enrolled in the Spring 2022, 460 (51%) re-enrolled for the Fall 2022.

### Degree-Seeking Students of Non-Graduates:

Of the 234 students who were degree-seeking in the Fall 2021, 76 (32%) re-enrolled for the Fall 2022.

Of the 169 students who were degree-seeking in the Spring 2022, 66 (39%) re-enrolled for the Fall 2022.

### Cohort Retention of Non-Graduates from Previous Two Years

Of the 16 Spring 2022 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 9 (56%) re-enrolled for Fall 2022.

Of the 107 Fall 2021 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 44 (41%) re-enrolled for Fall 2022.

Of the 20 Spring 2021 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 13 (65%) re-enrolled for Fall 2022.

Of the 53 Fall 2020 Cohort (first-time entering, award-seeking) students, 14 (26%) re-enrolled for Fall 2022.
