### Our Students:

1,093 students in all courses and terms this semester and 1,022 were registered in 7612 credit hours as of the fall census date reported to the Arkansas Dept of Higher Education and the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS).

### Of those students

- ❖ 19% were full-time
- ❖ 33% were part-time
- ❖ 52% were female
- ❖ 65% were students of color
- ❖ 19% were at least 25 years old
- ❖ 25% took only online courses
- ❖ 70 students were placed in English SLA or Extended SLA
- ❖ 103 were placed in Math SLA or Extended SLA

### 117 were first-time entering degree-seeking students. Of these students

- ❖ 58% were seeking an AA or AS Degree
- ❖ 42% were seeking an AAS Degree, Technical Certificate, or Certificate of Proficiency
- ❖ 50% graduated from a Crittenden County High School
- ❖ 6% earned a GED
- ❖ 66% received PELL funds

### 488 were concurrent high school students. Of these students:

- ❖ 63% were enrolled in Technical Center classes
- ❖ 36% were enrolled in General Education classes
- ❖ 1% were enrolled in both Gen Ed and Tech classes
- ❖ 160 were Goldsby scholars
- ❖ 43% were from West Memphis HS, 44% from Marion HS, 9% from Earle HS, and 3% from WMC

### Our Courses

- ❖ 151 unique courses with 287 total sections
- ❖ 173 day sections with 5050 enrolled credit hours
- ❖ 30 night sections with 590 enrolled credit hours
- ❖ 84 online sections with 3893 enrolled credit hours
