Students requiring SLA or Extended SLA are considered conditionally admitted. Students who are conditionally admitted must successfully complete, with a cumulative 2.0 GPA, the following courses within the first thirty (30) hours: ENGL 1113 English Composition I, ENGL 1123 English Composition II, required MATH course, and POLS 1143 American Government or HIST 2123 U.S. History Before 1877 or HIST 2133 U.S. History After 1877.

Acceptance of electives in transfer toward baccalaureate degree requirements at out-of-state institutions is solely at the discretion of the receiving institution. Students planning to transfer elective credit to four-year institutions outside Arkansas should contact the ASU Mid-South Registrar's Office or the Admissions Office of the transfer institution before enrolling in an elective to verify transferability to specific institutions.
